We are thrilled to be welcoming everyone to RUF! Ryde Ukulele Festival.

Where and when is it being held?

RUF is at Club Ryde, 728 Victoria Rd, Ryde on Sunday 17th of November 2024 from 10am to 8pm.

What is the cost of the tickets?

The tickets are only \$10 each plus booking fee. Purchase by scanning the QR code on our posters or on the website or there's a link on our website.

Tickets on the day

Once you have signed in, you will receive a wristband showing that you have paid. You can purchase tickets on the day.

What if I don't want to buy a ticket?

If you don't wish to purchase a ticket, you will not be allowed to stay. If seen by our staff without a wristband, you will be asked to leave. This is a ticketed only event for the entire day.

How do I get there?

Parking

We have plenty of above ground and underground parking. Our underground parking has access to a lift. There are six disabled spots. From the ground floor, here's 12 steps down to the greens, or you can access the greens via a ramp.

Stages

We are operating three (3) stages at RUF.

Main stage - located in the main level of our club.

Dome – located outside on our greens.

Theatre – upstairs on the 2nd level of the Club.

How many acts are there?

We have 32 acts across the 3 stages, starting at 10am and continuing until 5:50pm. You can see the list of performers on our website under the tab Ryde Ukulele Festival.

Will there be a jam session for everyone?

Yes! From 6pm til 7pm (or longer) will be an open jam session for everyone to join!

How many workshops are there?

We have four workshops that take place on our 2nd floor. Workshops are \$20 to attend.

What should I bring?

Your enthusiasm! There is seating in all three areas. However, if you'd like to bring your own picnic chairs and blankets, you are more than welcome to. Don't forget a hat and sunscreen for outside.

Where can we eat and drink? What facilities are available?

Club Ryde has a bistro in the main lounge serving Asian and western food. They also have daily specials. We are organizing food trucks and will update this information as we have it.

Toilets

There are toilets on every level, near every stage.

Wheelchair accessible?

All areas are wheelchair accessible except for the theatre which has five steps leading up to that level. Please plan accordingly.

Professional photographer
